RESOLUTION NO 2020-3

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF SADDLEBROOKE ADOPTING THE CHRISTIAN COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION *PLAN*

WHEREAS the Village of Saddlebrooke recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the Village of Saddlebrooke; and

WHEREAS the Village of Saddlebrooke has participated in the preparation of a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the Christian County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, hereafter referred to as the *Plan*, in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS the *Plan* identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the Village of Saddlebrooke from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS the Village of Saddlebrooke recognizes that land use policies have a major impact on whether people and property are exposed to natural hazards, the Village of Saddlebrooke will endeavor to integrate the *Plan* into the comprehensive planning process and

WHEREAS adoption by the Village of Saddlebrooke demonstrates their commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the *Plan*

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE OF SADDLEBROOKE, in the State of Missouri, THAT:

In accordance with Village of Saddlebrooke Board of Trustees, the Village of Saddlebrooke adopts the final FEMA-approved *plan*.
